In today's text Romans 5:12-17, Paul explains that sin and death entered the world through the one man Adam, and that death has been reigning over humanity since Adam, because all have sinned. But now, much more abounding grace has come as a free gift through the one man Jesus Christ, so that grace might now reign, bringing life and immortality to humanity through Him. In short, His Grace is Greater than all our sin! Hallelujah! Sin and death have come to all people through Adam, but God's free gift of abounding grace is for those who receive Christ. Now because God gives us the free gift of righteousness, that is right-standing with Him, abounding grace now reigns in life through Jesus. This is the good news of the Gospel!
